



Driving Directions

We are located just south of Safeco Field and just north of Starbucks Headquarters on 1st Ave S.

Bus parking is located southbound on 1st Ave South, directly in front of the museum, in the yellow loading/unloading zone.

Northbound on I-5

- Get on I-5 North
- Take exit 163 for West Seattle Bridge.
- Continue onto Spokane St Viaduct/West Seattle Bridge.
- Exit onto 1st Ave South.
- Turn left onto 1st Ave South.
- Continue on 1st Ave South until S. Stacy St. At the light, turn left.
- Proceed around the back of the building until S. Holgate St. Turn right.
- Turn right on 1st Ave S to head southbound toward the museum.
- Bus parking will be on the street directly in front of the museum (yellow loading zone).

Southbound on I-5

- Get on I-5 South

- Turn left onto 1st Ave South.
- Bus parking will be on the street directly in front of the museum (yellow loading zone).





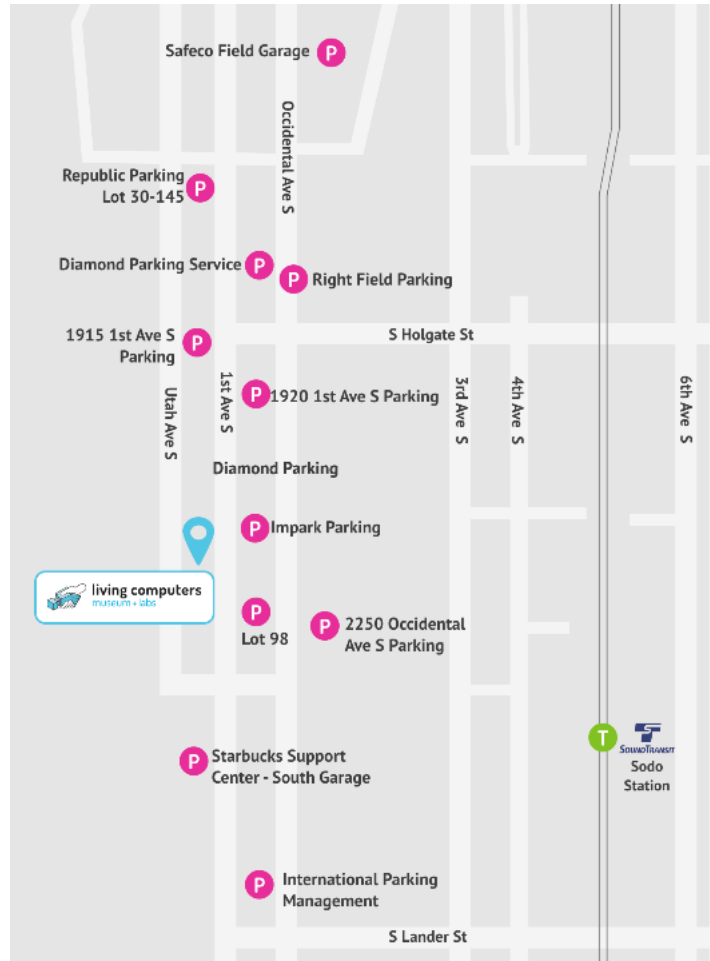
Public Transit Options

Light Rail

If you are taking the Sound Transit Link light rail, get off at the SODO station. Walk a few blocks west to 1st Avenue South down South Lander Street, then turn right to go north one block to the museum.

Note: From 2018 to 2020, construction on the new South Lander Street Bridge has closed the South Lander St to traffic between 1st Ave S and 3rd Ave S. Vehicles can use alternate routes on South Holgate or South Spokane Streets.

Pedestrian access will be maintained down S Lander St. All bike riders must dismount and walk their bikes through the pedestrian detour.
